


RIDE IN RWANDA

TIPS FOR AMATEUR RIDERS LOOKING TO "RIDE IT YOURSELF"

Ready to ride the UCI 2025 route or explore Rwanda's top trails on your own? Here are a few tips to make your adventure safe, fun, and unforgettable.

START EARLY



Rwanda's mornings are cool and clear, perfect for riding.

PACE YOURSELF



The climbs are real! Don't burn out early on long elevation gains.

HYDRATE OFTEN



Bring water or hydration packs, and refill at local shops or cafés.

FOLLOW THE ROUTE



Use GPX files for real-time trail navigation.

DRESS RIGHT



Light, breathable gear for the day, plus a light rain jacket.

RESPECT THE ROADS



Watch for local traffic, pedestrians, and livestock.

BE FRIENDLY



A simple wave or "Muraho" (hello) goes a long way in Rwandan villages.

KNOW YOUR LIMITS



Trails vary in difficulty. Start with easier routes if unsure.

JOIN A GROVP



Link up with local cycling clubs or guides for added support.



KIGALI





Kigali is Rwanda's vibrant heart, a city of rolling hills, well-paved roads, and endless views.

It offers riders a unique mix of urban cycling and natural landscapes, with routes that pass through neighborhoods, forests, and hilltops. If you're training or touring, Kigali is the perfect starting point.

The capital is also a hub for cycling culture, featuring regular Car-Free Days, local cycling clubs, and top-class infrastructure. After a ride, cyclists can relax in stylish cafés, explore museums and art galleries.

NORTHERN PROVINCE





The Northern Province is a dream for riders who love climbing and cool, fresh air. This region is surrounded by the towering volcanoes of the Virunga Massif, offering panoramic trails, highaltitude roads, and forest-lined paths.

Cyclists can explore scenic lakes like Burera and Ruhondo, pass through tea plantations, and ride towards the famous gorilla trekking zones of Volcanoes National Park. With quiet villages and welcoming communities along the way, it's the ideal mix of adventure, nature, and cultural discovery.

WESTERN PROVINCE





The Western Province is all about water, altitude, and wild beauty. Riders here can hug the shores of Lake Kivu, explore forested mountains, or challenge themselves on the legendary Congo Nile Trail, one of Africa's best-known multi-day rides. The terrain ranges from gentle lakeside paths to steep technical climbs.

The region has a lot to explore: lively towns by the lake, local coffee farms, and scenic tea plantations. For those who prefer a relaxed day ride or a challenging off-road trail, the Western Province offers unforgettable cycling with amazing views all around.

SOUTHERN PROVINCE







Rwanda's Southern Province combines scenic rides with deep cultural roots. Its rolling hills are home to historic towns, sacred sites, and lush tea plantations. Cyclists can enjoy smooth countryside loops, visit the spiritual site of Kibeho, or explore the academic atmosphere of Huye.

One of the region's gems is Kitabi, offering access to highaltitude trails near Nyungwe National Park. It's a peaceful yet challenging ride experience, with rainforest air and panoramic views. Whether you're here for the history or the high climbs, the south has something for every rider.

EASTERN PROVINCE



Eastern Rwanda offers a different kind of cycling experience: wide open roads, flat terrain, and serene landscapes. The region is ideal for those who enjoy long-distance rides with fewer climbs. It's known for peaceful paths through wetlands, lakesides, and endless agricultural fields.

This province is perfect for relaxed exploration, with routes passing farms and quiet villages. Riders can take in views of Lake Mugesera or pedal along the marshes of Bugesera. It's also one of the sunniest regions, a great place to slow down and soak it all in.
